Deadline for the final version of articles is November 19

In the period from November 19 to January 5, we'll be doing editing and proofreading.

We'll ask you to help read another writers article during this period.

In the period from January 5, we'll be doing layout. We'll try to send you a layout version of the article for you to accept.

Text

Please send us:

- Your article
- A short bio including your job, education, age, nationality, experience with larp and any other information you deem relevant (max 500 characters)
- Reference list/bibliography

Footnotes/endnotes

Please keep notes to an absolute minimum!

If necessary, always use footnotes.

Formatting

Please deliver your article in MS Word, OpenOffice or RTF-format.

Please only use the following formatting:

- Italic
- Headline 1, headline 2, headline 3

Do not use bold, center, different fonts etc. (It wont be included in the final version of the book)

Tables and illustrations

If you want to use images and illustrations, please contact us in advance.

If you want to use tables, please include all relevant data material (such as spreadsheets)

References

Put reference in brackets including authors name(s), year of publishing and (if relevant) page number.

Only include this information, all other information, such as book editor and publishing house in the reference list

Example:

She stated, "Students often had difficulty using APA style," (Jones, 1998: 199-204).

In the reference list include:

- Book: Surname, Firstname (Year): *Book Title*. Publishing house: City.
- Article: Surname, Firstname (Year): "Article Title" in Surname (ed.): *Book Title*, pp. xx-yy. Publishing house: City.
- Website: Surname, Firstname (Year): *Title*. Retrieved from <http://www.xyz.com> at date, month, year.
